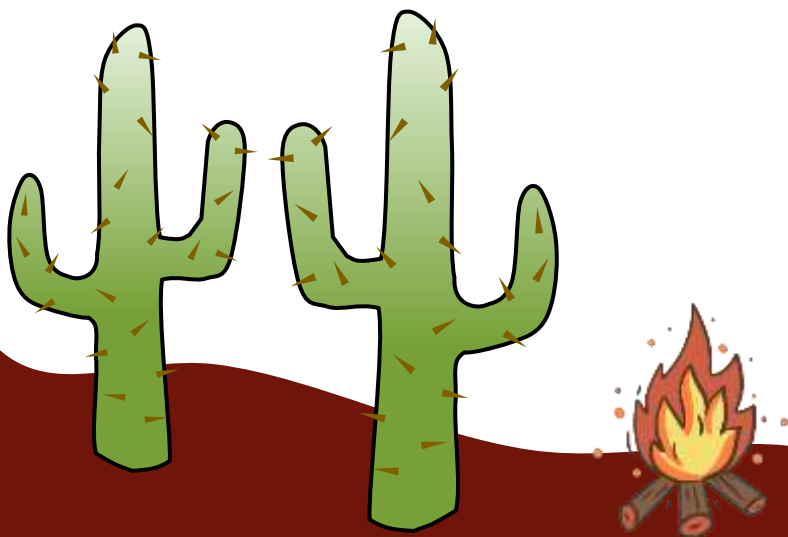

✓ Easy for Packs to Camp

- Tents with cots are provided
- All meals will be served in the camp dining hall, prepared by the kitchen staff
- Only A/B medical forms required, no part C
- No swim tests required in advanced, they will be given at camp
- Packs only need two registered adult leaders, BALOO not required
- Parents are also welcome*



✓ You just need to show up!

**Cub Scout Programs – Overnight Exception:* Cub Scout parents or legal guardians taking part in an overnight Cub Scout program with their own child or legal ward are not required to register as leaders. All adults must review the [“How to Protect your Children from Child Abuse: A Parent’s Guide”](#) that can be found in the front of each Cub Scout Handbook. In addition, the parent or legal guardian must be accompanied by a registered leader at any time they are with youth members other than their own child/ward. All other overnight adults must be currently registered in an adult fee required position.

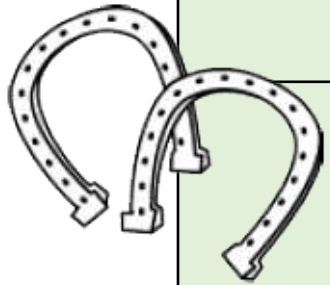

The Cub Adventure Camp will be run by the Ockanickon Summer Staff... and they are excited to bring their enthusiasm to Cub Scouts through this new program. This is absolutely going to be a great time for cubs as they interact with the seventy plus staff that make scouting magic happen year after year.

Packs will camp in tents provided by the camp and all meals will be served in the camp dining hall.

Cub Scouts are **\$300** by May 15th and **\$325** after May 15th. Adults are priced at \$150

Packs can pay with credit card or eCheck with a convenience fees, or register online and send a check to the Council office. Pack Registration opens on Wednesday, November 1st.

Important note: Washington Crossing Council is using Tentaroo Event Management for Cub Scout Adventure Camp Registration. This is a log-in system that allows your pack to make a deposit, build your camp roster and pay your camp fees via eCheck or credit card. Most WCC units have an existing account. Each rank starts with the Bobcat required Adventure each year. After earning Bobcat, each rank is earned by completing the other five required Adventures and two elective Adventures, in any order, for a total of eight Adventures.

FAQ (1/2)

Yes - There will be a leader guide

Can a family sign up? No - This is for Packs and is not Family Camp; You must register as a Pack and attend with a Pack; A Pack minimum would be two registered adult leaders and two cub scouts of the same gender

Are parents required to attend with their cubs? No* - *However, parent of the Tiger must attend. A pack must have a minimum of two registered adult leaders in attendance

Do parents need YTP? No - although it is encouraged; Packs need have parents review/sign the "How to Protect your Children from Child Abuse: A Parent's Guide"

Can a Packs attend both sessions? Yes - but Packs still need to leave and then come back for session 2, and current planning has the same activities schedules for each Adventure Camp

Can you bring our own tents? Yes - people have brought their own tent and set it up on the ground

Will there be free adults for packs if X amount of Cub Scouts from the pack attend? No - there are no discounts for bringing more Cub Scouts



FAQ (2/2)

Can you sign up if you don't know who the adults are? Yes - you can reserve your Pack's spot without knowing the details. It should be noted that Spots are not guaranteed until they are paid for. However, by being registered, council knows you are interested and will contact you when spots begin to become limited.



What is Polar Bear? Swimming before breakfast. The cooler morning air makes it a "Polar" swim :-)

Are there minimum weight limits or size for the climbing tower? No - Cub Scouts have climbed the tower.

Can siblings attend? No - All Cub Scouts must be registered in your Pack. Parents of attending Cub Scouts can attend.

Can you select your campsite? Yes* - There is an option on the registration page for a specific site. *However, as the week approaches, the camp staff selects the optimum arrangement for units in sites. They will take your requests into consideration.
